Call to Order

Mayor Symons called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

Roll Call

Board roll call was taken.

Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Transmission Line Notice of Award (bid acceptance) tabled from August 7, 2019 regular meeting

For schedules B, C, and D Scott Contracting is \$3,000 lower than RCD Construction, \$9,411.16 lower than Native Excavating and \$25,759.63 lower than United Companies. Mayor Symons said he preferred working with a local company. Tyler Clyde with Scott Contracting arrived at the meeting at this point and was asked why Scott Contracting should be considered for the project. Mr. Clyde said that Scott Contracting has an office in Rifle and workers who live in Grand Junction, Rifle and Glenwood Springs and they are trying to grow their western slope business. They are part of a bigger company with many resources and additional expertise. The schedule for the work was discussed and Mr. Clyde said there is some concern with the weather, but they are ready to start as soon as they receive the notice to proceed. They believe they should be able to complete the work in about a month from the start date. Following discussion, Trustee Lewis moved to award the bid for Schedules B, C, and D of the transmission line replacement in the total amount of

\$603,369.37 to Scott Contracting. Trustee McLaughlin seconded the motion and the motion passed on the following roll call vote: McLaughlin – yes, Symons – yes, Drust – yes and Lewis – yes.

The business of the special meeting being concluded, Mayor Symons called for adjournment. Trustee Lewis moved to adjourn, Trustee McLaughlin seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously on voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
