Trustee Lewis moved to enter executive session to discuss personnel matters, specifically to conduct an interview for the Public Works Superintendent position pursuant to C.R.S. §24-6-402(4)(f). Discussion of and possible consideration of candidate for Public Works Superintendent position contingent upon satisfactory background, reference, and driver's license checks (Note: Town Board may not have sufficient information to make a decision at this time) and/or next steps

Following discussion, Trustee Lewis moved to offer Craig Fetkavich the position of Public Works Superintendent at an annual salary of \$55,000, with a benefit package of paid health insurance, health reimbursement arrangement, paid time off and holidays. Mr. Fetkavich holds a Colorado Class C water operator's license and he will be expected to obtain a Class D wastewater, Class 1 collections, and Class 1 distribution licenses within one year of his start date. Trustee Drust seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously on voice vote.

Adjournment


