### Vaccines Available:

Canine: rabies, dhl-p with leptospirosis (distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parvovirus, and coronavirus), kennel cough. Lyme & giardia are not available.

Feline: rabies, distemper including leukemia.

Vaccine prices will be announced. Check next month’s newsletter.

Dr. Dayna Baillo from Mountain Peaks Vet Clinic will administer vaccines.

Yampa Pet License’s can be obtained with proof of rabies vaccination.

Spayed and Neutered pets: \$2.00; Intact pets: \$5.00

Payments for vaccines must be made separately from payments for Town licenses. **Cash or check only.**
